The National Gallery of Ireland has announced details ____ its <u>upcoming</u> exhibition, 'Vermeer and the Masters of Genre Painting: Inspiration and Rivalry', opening ____ June 2017. Conceived by the National Gallery of Ireland, this exhibition will bring together some 60 paintings from around the world. The exhibition will explore the fascinating network of relationships between Vermeer and Dutch genre painters ____ the period 1650 to 1675, and will give visitors an <u>insight ____</u> how Vermeer and his contemporaries admired, inspired and rivalled each other.

As many as ten works by Johannes Vermeer (1632-1675) will be included in the exhibition. This is <u>nearly</u> a third of Vermeer's surviving oeuvre and the third highest number of works _____ the artist ever <u>assembled</u> in the world.

The Gallery's own Vermeer, *Woman Writing a Letter with Her Maid_c.*1670, which is regarded as one of the artist's <u>finest</u> works, will be shown alongside other exquisite works including *Woman with a Balance*, c.1663–4 (National Gallery of Art, Washington); *Woman with a Pearl Necklace*, 1663-4 (Staatliche Museen zu Berlin); *The Astronomer*, 1668 (Musée du Louvre, Paris) and *The Geographer*, 1669 (Städel Museum, Frankfurt-am-Main). Paintings of daily life _____ contemporaries of Vermeer, including Gerrit Dou, Gerard ter Borch, Jan Steen, Gabriel Metsu, Pieter de Hooch and Frans van Mieris, will also feature.

Dr Adriaan E. Waiboer, Curator of Northern European Art, National Gallery of Ireland says: "Vermeer and his contemporaries constantly tried to <u>surpass</u> each other's work _____ technical <u>prowess</u> and aesthetic <u>appeal</u>. Their creative rivalry contributed _____ the exceptionally high quality of their combined oeuvre. Visitors to this exhibition will be able to observe that artists had individual ways of inserting, changing and <u>disguising</u> their borrowings." He adds: "We have been working on this exhibition since 2011 and it will be one _____ the most important exhibitions of seventeenth-century Dutch art taking place worldwide in 2017."

A documentary film, entitled, 'Vermeer - The Man His Time His World' is currently ____ production, to be released in 2017 as one of the events associated with the National Gallery of Ireland's exhibition.
